



# Challenge 1? Humanitarian reporting – timely and accurately

Number of partners growing by day

- Cumbersome excel spreadsheets difficult to analyse
- Multiple monitoring/reporting channels
- Errare humanum est





# Humanitarian performance monitoring


Standardized 5Ws form for collecting detailed data directly from partners involved in field activities, across multiple categories, making it easy for partners to report their activities accurately and systematically


Holistic training sessions – frameworks, definitions, subactivities

Integration of Activity Info form with PowerBi for dashboards. A visual tool to help programme colleagues monitor their partners performance

Streamlining all reporting requirements and data collection tools (Inter-Agency, Regional response)

Supported real-time data analysis and decision-making, helping to ensure that partner activities align with UNICEF's strategic goals and response plans





# Challenge 2? Supply distribution

- CO massive supply like NEVER before
- Global supply monitoring not yet rolled out
- Quick solution needed






An intermediate solution – till the global system rollout

Integration with PowerBi allowed for real-time data available in a dashboard

- Qualitative inputs in Word.doc
- Varying styles
- Difficult to systematize and analyse
- Untraceable trends



#### Field reporting

From Word we transition to Activity Info standardized forms to collect qualitative updates from the field colleagues from different geographic zones of the country


An Informative bulletin

Real-time Snapshots: Provides up-to-date information on the current situation, significant changes in programming, key meetings with government officials and other stakeholders, and other relevant data points.

Complementary Data: In addition to qualitative reports from field colleagues, the dashboard is supplemented with relevant demographic data such as education enrollment, border movements, and county profiles with statistical data.

Support Tool for Emergency Coordinator: Enhances decision-making and strategic planning.

Expanded its scope for nexus approach



### Challenge 4? Funds monitoring – from proposal to utilisation


- Need for coordinated fundraising and proposals tracking
- Need for one-stop shop
- Multiplicity of requirements AND sources

Tracking how donor proposals were addressing the Country office funding gaps for both Country Programme and Humanitarian Appeal for Children

- No overview on trends
- Manual data manipulation
- Need to guide volunteers







#### 👼 🗗 Social media monitoring & dashboard integration






- Standardized form on key topics
- Integrated with PBI for a comprehensive AAP dashboard



- Increased reporting from online UNVs
- Improved and facilitated analysis
- Less time spent on data manipulation, more time on analysis and recommendations



#### Approach to Information Management



#### **Integral support function:**

- Streamlined, collaborative office-as-a-whole work
- 'One vision' Effective refugee response and overall programme management

#### **Complementarity and inter-connectedness:**

- One component feeds into another and one solution opens the door to others
- Simple tweaks enable comprehensive work solutions

#### **End-user focus:**

- User-friendly and adaptable to evolving contexts
- Tools must be used to be effective
- IM linked to Knowledge Management (processes, guidelines, capacity building)



Start small but think big:)

- -from prototype to mass use
- with regular audits for quality and compliance
- mind capacities and mindsets




Kaleidoscope approach – from flat lifeless spreadsheets to telling a story – you pick!
