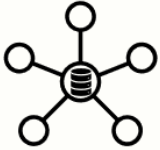

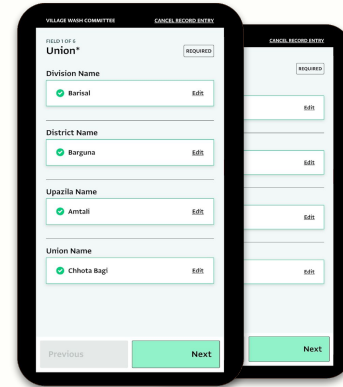


Advantages of using ActivityInfo

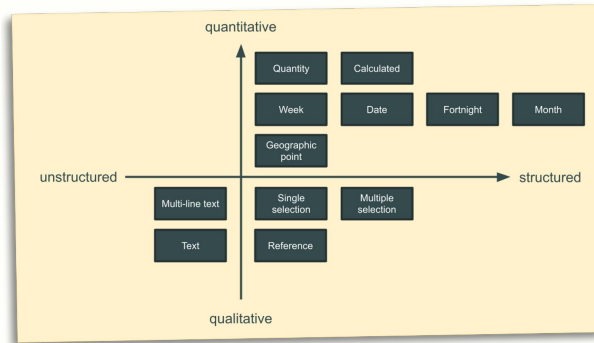
ActivityInfo Mobile App

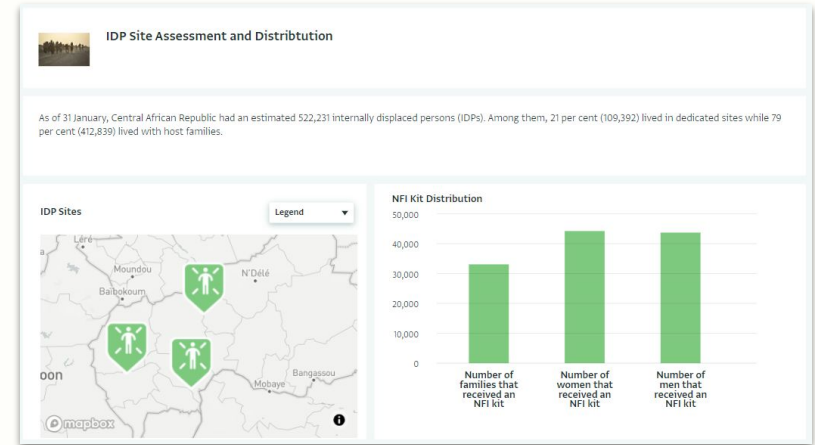
Validation rules reduce errors at data entry

Advantages of using ActivityInfo

System is more scalable



- 1000s of users
- 1,000,000s of records
- No storage limits
- No hardware required (SaaS)

Database structure

Limit	Value	Unit
Maximum number of Users with access to a Database	10,000	Users
Maximum number of Forms in a Database	500	Forms
Maximum number of Subforms in a Form	30	Subforms
Maximum number of Records in a Form	200,000	Records
Maximum number of fields in a Form	600	fields
Maximum Folder depth	10	Folder within Folder
Maximum Subform depth	5	Subform within Subform

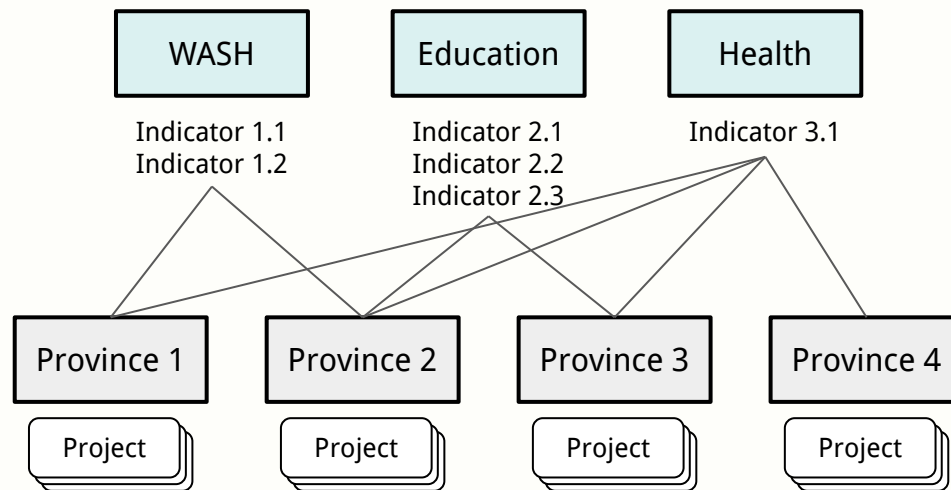
Current Database limits - highly scalable

ActivityInfo is based on a Relational Information Model

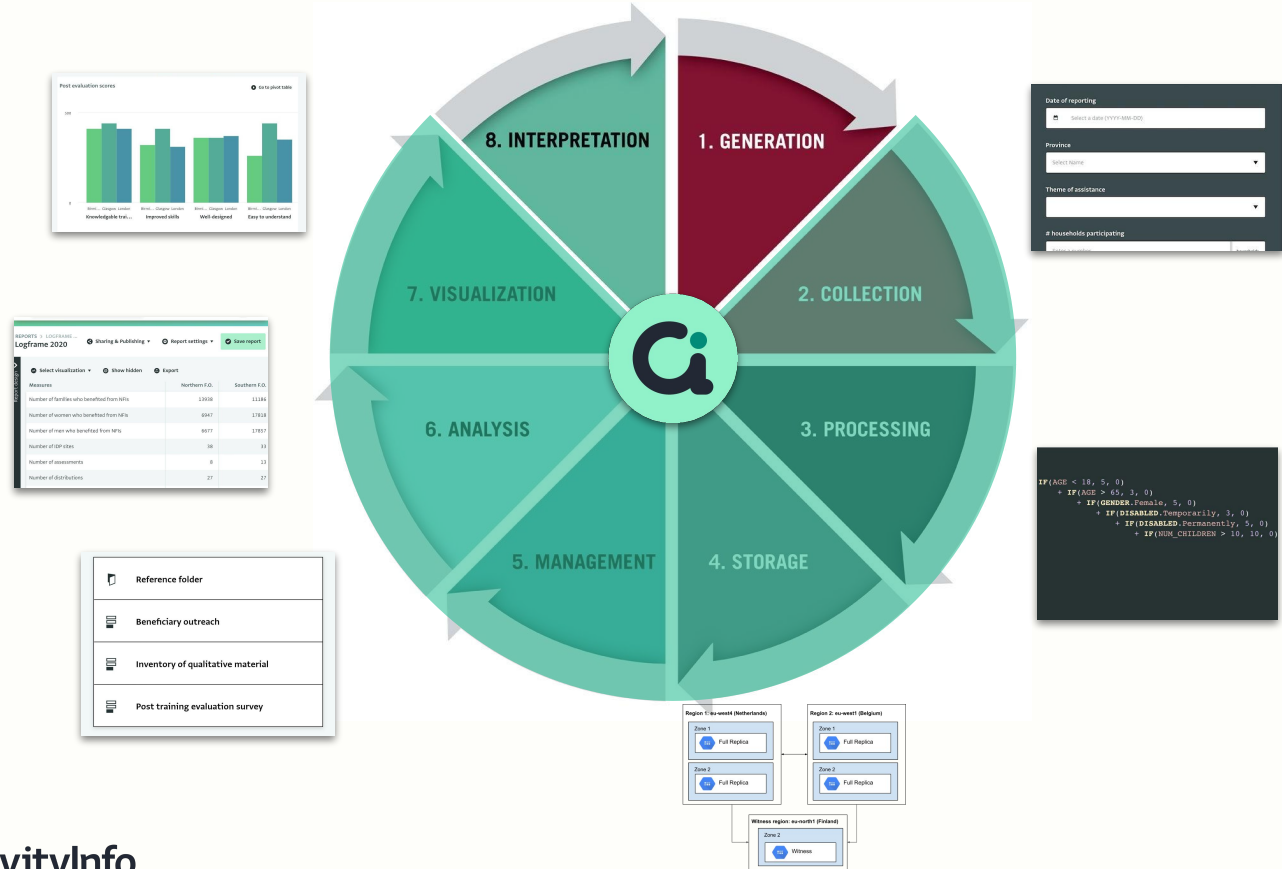
