Key Questions (Standards)	Means of Verification	Score (0, 1, 2, NA)	Observations, rationale for rating and recommendations
<b>2. M&amp;E Plans and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)</b>			
1. Does the program have an up-to-date (annual updates) Monitoring Evaluation and Learning Plan (MELP)/Performance Monitoring Plan (PMP) that includes a graphic Results Framework or Theory of Change outlining how project/program goals, intermediate results, and outcomes or outputs are linked?	Discussion, review of MELP/PMP		
2. Does the program set targets for key performance indicators to achieve every month and quarter for each intervention?	Discussion, review of MELP/PMP		
3. Does the MELP have a dataflow chart that clearly demonstrates how data flows and is reviewed from implementation sites to reach program managers and donors/government?	Discussion, review of MELP/PMP		
4. Does the MELP plan have an organogram describing the organization of the M&E unit in relation to the overall project team?	Discussion, review of MELP/PMP

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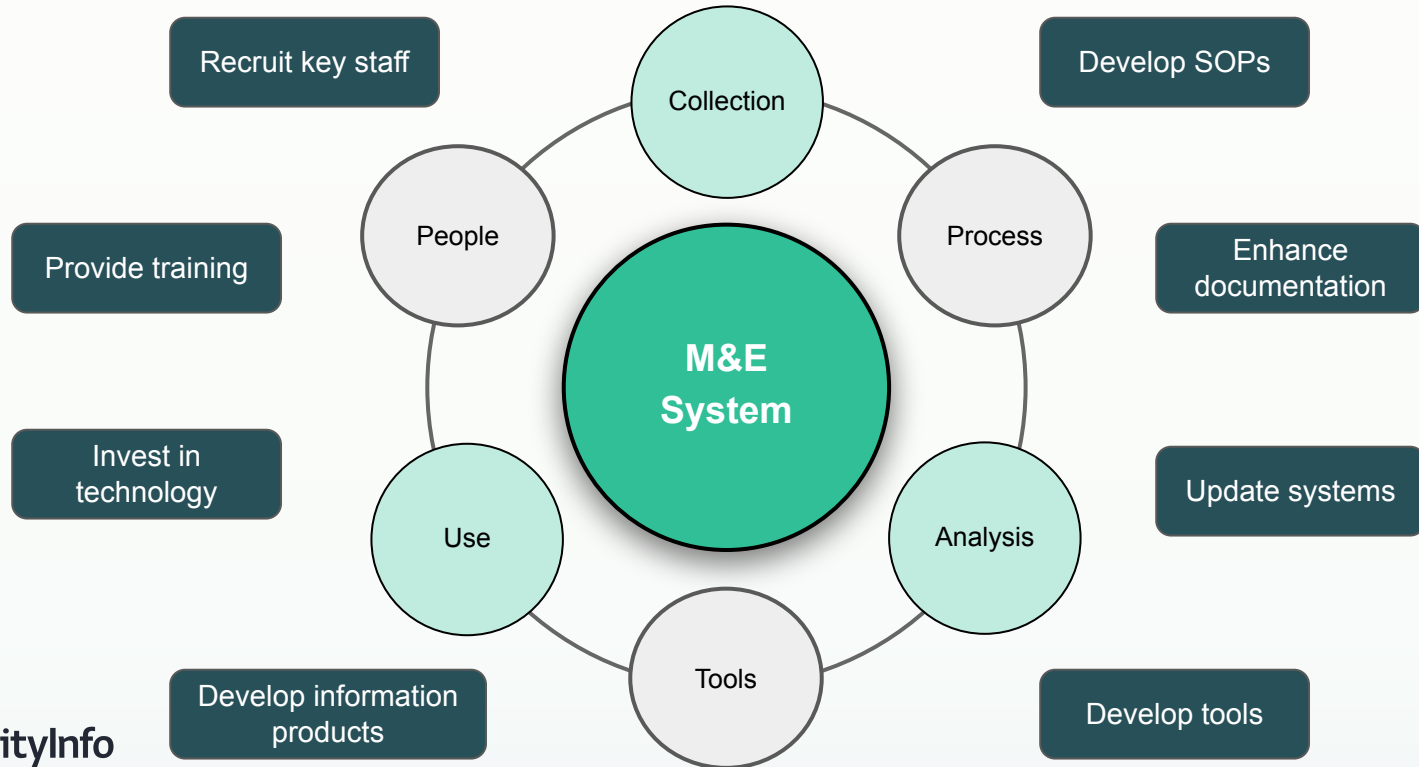

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Baseline assessment</li><li>• Organizational level</li><li>• Document review, interviews and survey</li></ul>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Unclear responsibilities</li><li>2. Inefficient reporting process</li><li>3. Missing key M&amp;E elements (e.g. ToC) and some gaps in knowledge of M&amp;E related concepts</li><li>4. Poor data quality due to lack of centralized information system</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Formalized roles and responsibilities</li><li>2. Updated reporting procedures for key organizational indicators</li><li>3. Launched ToC roll out process with capacity building to ensure all projects had a ToC</li><li>4. Launched a procurement process for a software solution for a central information management system</li></ol>
